SUBJECT: Guidance Memorandum #1 for BAFI 32-7064, *Recreation, Hunting, and Fishing Activities*, signed 11 Aug 17

1. This Guidance Memorandum immediately changes BAFI 32-7064, *Recreation, Hunting, and Fishing Activities*. Compliance with this Memorandum is mandatory. To the extent directions are inconsistent with other Air Force publications the information herein prevails, in accordance with AFI 33-360, *Publications and Forms Management*.
2. The following rules are specific to implementation of recreation, hunting and fishing guidance that apply to all persons engaged in hunting and fishing. Checked in hunters are to actively participate. Paragraph 13.8 is amended to read:
  - 13.8. Checked-in hunters may not leave the East Reservation and are prohibited from loitering in base housing or any non-hunting areas.
3. Ensure all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this Memorandum are maintained in accordance with AF Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, Management of Records, and disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) located at <https://afrims.amc.af.mil/>.
4. This policy is effective immediately. The policy established herein becomes void after 180 days have elapsed from the date of this Memorandum, or when incorporated by interim change or revision to BAFI 32-7064. All attached enclosures are previously approved guidance changes that remain in effect and will be incorporated by interim change or revision of AFI 32-6001.
